## **PFLAG Policy Matters: December 16, 2016**

[U.S. House Freedom Caucus proposes to revoke important LGBTQ protections](#). Released on December 15th, [the House Freedom Caucus document](#) outlines more than 200 rules, regulations and executive orders it wants to revoke, targeting federal guidance on the fair and equal treatment of transgender students from the Department of Education and nondiscrimination protections for LGBTQ people in the Affordable Care Act.

The attempts to circumvent the legal right to marry continued [in Mississippi](#) (where the attempt failed); [in Texas](#) (where the attempt failed); [in Alabama](#) (where the attempt failed); and [in Florida](#) (where the attempt failed). With more than 100 vacant judgeships and at least one Supreme Court justice seat that will be filled in the upcoming years, PFLAG will remain vigilant and oppose any efforts to roll back that marriage for all is the law of the land.
