Meeting Summary - January 19, 2025

A Teaching Faculty and Research Administrator in the Information School at the UW-Madison was our speaker. His teaching and research focus on diversity, equity, inclusion and accessibility in academic libraries but he also spoke about public libraries especially as it relates to LGBTQIA+ folks. He spoke passionately about library services being inclusive for all people. He spoke about the importance for all people to feel they can go into a library and be treated with basic human respect recognizing the diversity that exists PFLAG in the world today. He spoke about the importance of reference desks being inclusive, being unbiased and non-judgmental when it comes to folks asking about possible sensitive issues. He stressed it is important to have a robust collection of LGBTQIA+ resources; not only about sexuality but also about topics related to health, health care, networks, relationships, dating, joyful living and self-discovery along with a fiction collection for all ages. Above all, he spoke about the importance of creating a welcoming space for everyone. This means creating a welcoming space for LGBTQIA+ youth who may be exploring their identify and seeking information in a supportive environment but also it is important to note that a library isn't only about creating a welcome space for youth. It can also be a place for older adults who are coming into their own identities because it wasn't something that was talked about 20, 30 or 40 years ago.
